Year 5-7 pupils can find out the answers to questions like:

- How was ice made available without the use of a freezer?
- Why are the pans in the kitchen made the way they are?
- How do the staff keep the materials in the castle from being damaged?
- How and why do you put a castle to bed for the winter?
- How was the castle built without the machines we have today?
- Why was the slave trade important to the castle?

There will be workshops, talks, tours and chance to make a display.

The activities will be led by staff from the National Trust and members of the Education Department at Bangor University.
